COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT AND PUBLIC WORKS WILL BE HAVING A CENTRALIZED NEIGHBORHOOD CLEAN-UP DAY

Residents of the City of Norcross can drop off any bulky items, trash, old appliances/furniture and any other accumulated trash or unwanted items.

Solvent or hazardous material (batteries, paint, large car parts, motor, tires, oil, anti-freeze, concrete, household chemicals and similar items) WILL NOT BE ALLOWED. Items must be of reasonable size and environmentally safe in order to be disposed of properly.

If you have a large vehicle that can be used for hauling, think of organizing a group to help your neighbors (especially the elderly.)

We will also have a run-off dumpster for recyclables only. We will accept the same type items you put out with your weekly recyclables – plastic, paper, cardboard, aluminum, phone books, and similar items. Recyclable items must be separate from the other items you are discarding.
