

1. COTTON GIN MURAL

The historic Cotton Gin was once owned by the Summerour family who developed a new variety of cotton making them famous across the country and now resides as a home for local merchants.

2. EASTERN CONTINENTAL DIVIDE MOSAIC SCULPTURE

To commemorate the Eastern Continental Divide in Thrasher Park, this sculpture by artist Jennifer Freeman depicts intertwining streams in a stunning mosaic design.

3. FROGS IN THRASHER PARK

Don't forget to snap a picture with the Bench and Painter Frogs by artist Beau Smith as you walk through Thrasher Park as these friendly creatures have become a local staple to our art community.

4. GREETINGS FROM NORCROSS MURAL

The Greetings From Norcross Mural located along the Wingo Street facade mimics an Americana travel postcard and celebrates 8 iconic people and places in Norcross's history.

5. HERITAGE PARK STAIRS MURAL

Keep an eye out for a colorful new edition to our art scene with the unveiling of the Heritage Park Stairs Mural on October 12th!

6. LOVE, NORCROSS MURAL

The Love, Norcross Mural is a love letter to those spending a day in our historic downtown and serves as a bookend to the Greetings from Norcross Mural.

7. MITCHELL ROAD MOSAIC WALL

Witness true collaboration at the Mitchell Road Mosaic Wall which was completed by over 1,000 local students and volunteers to celebrate nature's beauty and significance.

8. NORCROSS LETTERS

A gift to the city from The Brunswick development, this colorful and welcoming sign represents the many facades of our vibrant city, such as sustainability and music!

9. PAINTED LITTLE FREE LIBRARIES

As an ode to sustainability, the Little Free Libraries located in Discovery Garden Park and the pollinator garden at City Hall depict painted garden scenes.

10. PAINTED SEWER STRUCTURES

Art can be found anywhere so don't miss the mural art of adorable animals on the sewer structures in Johnson Dean Forest Preserve and on the Hunter-Walker trail done by local artist Angelika Domschke!

11. REIMAGINE SCULPTURES

Discover a set of unique sculptures by artist Richard Sells throughout downtown Norcross where environmental awareness and recycling is explored through art.

12. SUNFLOWER MURAL

Designed by artist Arthur Smith, the Sunflower Mural located near Skin Alley captures two prominent themes in Norcross—the city's love and legacy of trains, along with its penchant for live music.

13. SURPRISES AT DISCOVERY GARDEN PARK

From creative 'leaf' bike racks and 'feed me' garbage bins to beautifully painted garden beds, Discovery Garden is full of artful surprises!

14. THRASHER PARK SIDEWALK MOSAIC

As you enter Thrasher Park, take a look at the whimsical sidewalk mosaic adapted by Jennifer Freeman, featuring the work of Norcross artist Anne Labaire.

15. TUMBLEFIELD MURAL

Skin Alley is known as our "ArtWay" with the Tumblefield Mural centerstage at Social Fox Brewery depicting Norcross's mischievous and iconic red foxes!

16. VETERANS PARK SCULPTURES

The iron sculptures of saluting soldiers in Veterans Park memorialize and honor the service of our veteran community.

17. WINGSPAN

A recent addition to Norcross' public art (as of 2024), the Wingspan Mural at John Dean Forest Preserve showcases a wide variety of wildlife against a scenic landscape, with a special focus on educating and highlighting bird species.
